13	information on immunizations, infectious diseases,
14	medications, or other school health issues to parents and
15	guardians of students in grades K through 12, then all of the
16	following information about influenza disease and its vaccine
17	shall be included:
18	(1) A description of causes, symptoms, and means of
19	transmission.
20	(2) A list of sources for additional information.
21	(3) Related recommendations issued by the Advisory
22	Committee on Immunization Practices of the federal Centers for
23	Disease Control and Prevention.
24	(b) The Department of Education, in cooperation with
25	the Department of Public Health, shall develop and make

1	available the information about influenza disease and its
2	vaccine to local school systems as required under subsection
3	(a) in an efficient manner that may include posting the
4	information on its website.
5	(c) A board, board member, or an employee of a local
6	board of education shall be immune from civil liability for
7	acts or omissions in the implementation of this section in
8	accordance with Section 36-1-12.
9	(c) A board, board member, or an employee of a local
10	board of education shall be immune from civil liability for
11	acts or omissions in the implementation of this section in
12	accordance with Section 36-1-12.
13	(d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
14	establish a standard of care for hospitals or physicians or
15	otherwise modify, amend, or supersede any provision of the
16	Alabama Medical Liability Act of 1987 or the Alabama Medical
17	Liability Act of 1996, or any amendment thereto, or any
18	judicial interpretation thereof. The information developed, or
19	made available, under this section shall not constitute a
20	standard for the practice of medicine.
21	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
22	first day of the third month following its passage and
23	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
